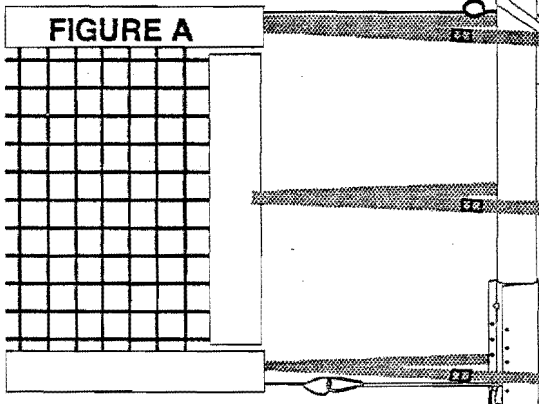

TWO NYLON WEBBING GUY CABLES PER POLE, CONSTRUCTED FROM 4000 LB. TEST WEB. EACH GUY UTILIZES 1500 LB. RATED NON-SLIP STEEL CAM-BUCKLE CINCHES. WEBBING LOOPS OVER THE TOP OF THE POLE AND REST ON EYE BOLT FOR QUICK AND SECURE SETUP.

THREE SECTION TELESCOPING AIRCRAFT ALUMINUM POLES. CLEAR ANODIZE COATING FOR A LIFETIME OF USE. THE POLES PROVIDE FOR MEN'S, WOMEN'S, AND JUNIOR VOLLEYBALL PLAYING HEIGHTS. QUICK PUSH BUTTON HEIGHT ADJUSTMENT WITH DOUBLE REINFORCED SNAP BUTTONS. A CAM-BUCKLE IS MOUNTED ON A ADJUSTABLE RAIL FOR BOTTOM NET CABLE TENSION.

FOURTEEN INCH CASE HARDEN STEEL STAKES, FOLDED OVER TOP PROVIDES FOR ADDED SAFETY. A STEEL DEE RING ON EACH GUY, FOR QUICK AND SECURE STAKE ATTACHMENT, IN SAND OR GRASS.

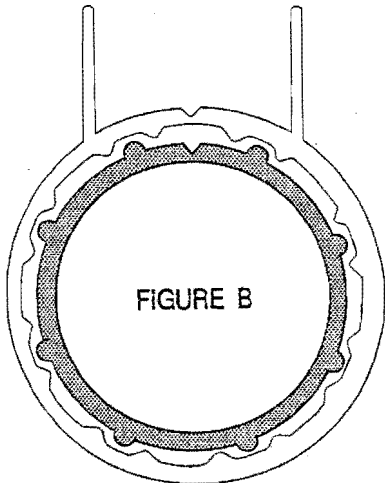

SMALL GROOVE IN BOTH TOP, BOTTOM, AND MIDDLE TUBES, HAS TO BE ALIGNED WITH EACH OTHER BEFORE TELESCOPING TUBES TOGETHER. OUTSIDE RIBS ON TOP AND BOTTOM TUBES WILL LINE UP INTO DOUBLE RIB SLOT ON INSIDE OF MIDDLE TUBE. IN-BETWEEN THE TWO OUTSIDE RAILS. SNAP BUTTON WILL THEN POP INTO PLACE AT EACH PLAYING HEIGHT.

LIMITED WARRANTY

Ultimate Systems Limited warrants the volleyball set to be free from defects in material and workmanship under normal conditions for a period of one year from date of original purchase, with the below listed exceptions. Aluminum standards are warranty for a period of five years from date of original purchase. Boundary rope, netting, and stakes are warranty for a period of 30 days. If within said period any part is found to be defective, the part will be repaired or replaced at no cost to the original purchaser for repair.

SERVICE

Customer service is available in the continental United States by following the proper procedure as outlined below:
IN-WARRANTY SERVICE: If it has been determined that there is a problem with any part of the system, the purchaser should call USL for authorization and then return the part with copy of proof of purchase, freight prepaid to: Ultimate Systems Limited, 4335 Santa Fe Dr., Kingman, AZ 86401. Under the terms of the warranty the part will be repaired or replaced and returned freight prepaid to the purchaser.

OUT-OF-WARRANTY SERVICE: If, after the warranty period has elapsed and a problem has developed with the system, the purchaser should call USL for authorization and then return the part freight prepaid. The part will be repaired or replaced and returned to the purchaser C.O.D. unless other payment has been arranged.

LIABILITIES AND LIMITATIONS

Unless specifically prohibited by state law, Ultimate Systems Limited assumes no responsibility for personal injury or property damage, resulting from the playing of net games, product not installed pursuant to instructions, consumer misuse, consumer negligence or an act of God; and in such event, any and all expressed or implied warranties are void. Damaged materials are assumed to be caused by consumer negligence and charges will be made for repair or replacement. All implied warranties are limited to the term of the express warranties as set out and shall not exceed, five years on Aluminum standards, 30 days on boundary rope, netting, stakes and one year

VOLLEYBALL RULES

COURT DIMENSIONS:

Standard size of court is 30 feet wide and 60 feet long. Width and length, however, can be changed depending on the area available for play.

NUMBER AND POSITIONING OF PLAYERS:

Each team shall have not more than six players with equal amounts of players on each side of court. Once the ball crosses over the net on the serve, players may move anywhere on their own side of the net.

SERVICE:

Each player shall serve in turn and will continue to serve until side is out. When serving, the ball must go over the net; if the ball hits the net when served and goes over the net, the ball must be re-served. If the ball does not go over the net when served or is out of bounds or touches any teammate before touching an opponent or opponent's court, the side is out and the opponent takes possession and becomes the serving team. The server must release the ball from his other hand before striking it.

SERVICE AREA:

The service area should be a minimum of five feet in depth behind the end boundary line and in the event the playing area does not provide space for such depth, then the serving area shall extend into the court to whatever distance is necessary. The service area should be located in the right end section of each court, the width not to exceed nine feet nine inches.

VOLLEY:

Maximum of three team contacts - each team is allowed a maximum of three successive contacts of the ball in order to return the ball to the opponent's area. Should two or more teammates play the ball at the same moment, two contacts shall be counted. However, if two players go for the ball but only one touches it, then only one contact is counted.

ROTATION:

After a team has lost its serve, the team receiving the ball for the first serve shall, before serving, rotate one position clockwise.

SCORING & PENALTY:

Only the serving team can score. When the serving team fails to score, it is "side out" and the receiving team becomes the serving team. The penalty for fouls or errors committed shall be "point" or "side out", as the case may be.

THE GAME:

The game shall be played for 15 points or, upon agreement by both teams, 21 points may constitute a game. A game must be won by a margin of two points. If the game is tied at 14 (or 20), play continues until one team has a two-point lead. A new game is begun by the team not serving at the end of the preceding game. A match consists of two out of three games.

ERRORS:

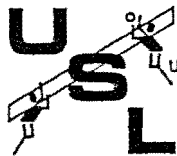
An error occurs if, while the ball is in play, a player: Does not clearly hit the ball or allows the ball to come to rest in any part or parts of the body. Hits the ball out of boundaries of the court. Allows the ball to hit the ground, or any object outside or over the court (except net), before being legally returned to the opponent's court. Touches the ball twice in succession. Fails to make a good serve. "Spikes" the ball on the opponent's side of the net. Crosses the center line when play is in progress.

FOULS:

Holding the ball or throwing it. If the ball touches any part of the body, except the hands or forearms, unless other body contact previously agreed upon by both teams. Touching the net with any part of the body or hands, or reaching over the net (spiking). If player plays out of position when ball is being served. If team has more than three successive contacts with the ball.
